Instructions to Bidders

5. ALL BIDS SHALL BE TOTALED REGARDLESS OF THE NUMBER OF VEHICLES BID. THIS TOTAL SHALL BE FIRM AND IRREVOCABLE. Totals shall appear in the spaces provided on the bottom of this page along with an anticipated delivery date for each bid.
6. The Intermediate Unit is exempt from all federal, state and local taxes; therefore, the bid price shall be net of any taxes.
7. The Board of Directors reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids for any reason or no reason. The Board of Directors is anticipating a purchase of five vehicles. The actual purchase will consist of any combination of the types specified upon mutual agreement of seller and the Board.
8. Bids shall be received at the Office of the Executive Director, 4500 6th Avenue, Altoona, PA 16602, until 12:00 Noon, April 7, 2006. All bid envelopes shall be properly sealed and appropriately marked on the outside of the envelope, "Vehicle Bid - Attention: Carrie Myers". Bids will be opened publicly April 7, 2006 at 2:30 pm in the conference room. Action will be taken regarding such bids at the April 27, 2006 board meeting.

- 2 Forward facing fold down flip seats and 2 stationary seats on driver's side and one single stationary seat on lift side, covered in vinyl with seat belts (per attached floor plan).
- Driver's seat is a high back, covered in vinyl, with seat belt.

WHEELCHAIR LIFT:

- Braun NL 900 Millennium Series fully automatic lift with manual back-up system or equivalent.
- Two folding handrails.
- Lift controls provide for maximum accessibility for attendant.
- Lift platform has a usable width of 33" and length of 51".
- Includes circuit cutoff installed in-line.
- Lift fully complies with Americans with Disabilities Act.

WHEELCHAIR SECUREMENT SYSTEM:

- One (1), located behind driver.
- Includes flush mounted L tracking installed in flooring with four-point tie down system.
- 108" seat belt for wheelchair passenger, along with height adjustable shoulder belt.
- Titan Retractor Tie downs by Sure-Lok or equivalent.
- A wall mounted storage pouch shall be supplied for storage of tie downs.

DOORS:

Entrance:

- Driver operated, manually controlled, sedan style front entry door.
- Right front passenger door is raised and stepwell is lowered for ease of boarding.
- Ground to first step is less than 10".
- Includes a stepwell light and interior lighting that is automatically activated with door opening.

Wheelchair Door:

- Located curbside at side cargo doors.
- Raised header to allow for ease of movement while loading and unloading wheelchair passengers.
- A brake Interlock is installed on the wheelchair lift door per A.D.A., with a master power switch located on the dash.
- Lift doors also incorporate a light in the skirt panel for operation during evening hours.

ROOF:

- 30” transit style roof extension with integrated steel roll cage welded to chassis.
- Includes a smooth interior liner throughout.
- Total interior headroom is 75”.

AIR CONDITIONING/HEATING:

- Ceiling mounted rear combination system or equivalent that provides a minimum of 24,000 B.T.U.’s of air conditioning/heating and is integrated with front (chassis) system.
- Contains a heater shutoff valve for summer time usage.
- All heating and air conditioning controls are located in driver’s area, within easy reach.

FLOOR COVERING:

- Exterior grade plywood underlayment, covered with transit style non-slip rubber floor covering located throughout van.
- Entrance stepwell also provides white nosing on edge of steps to identify each step.

STANCHIONS:

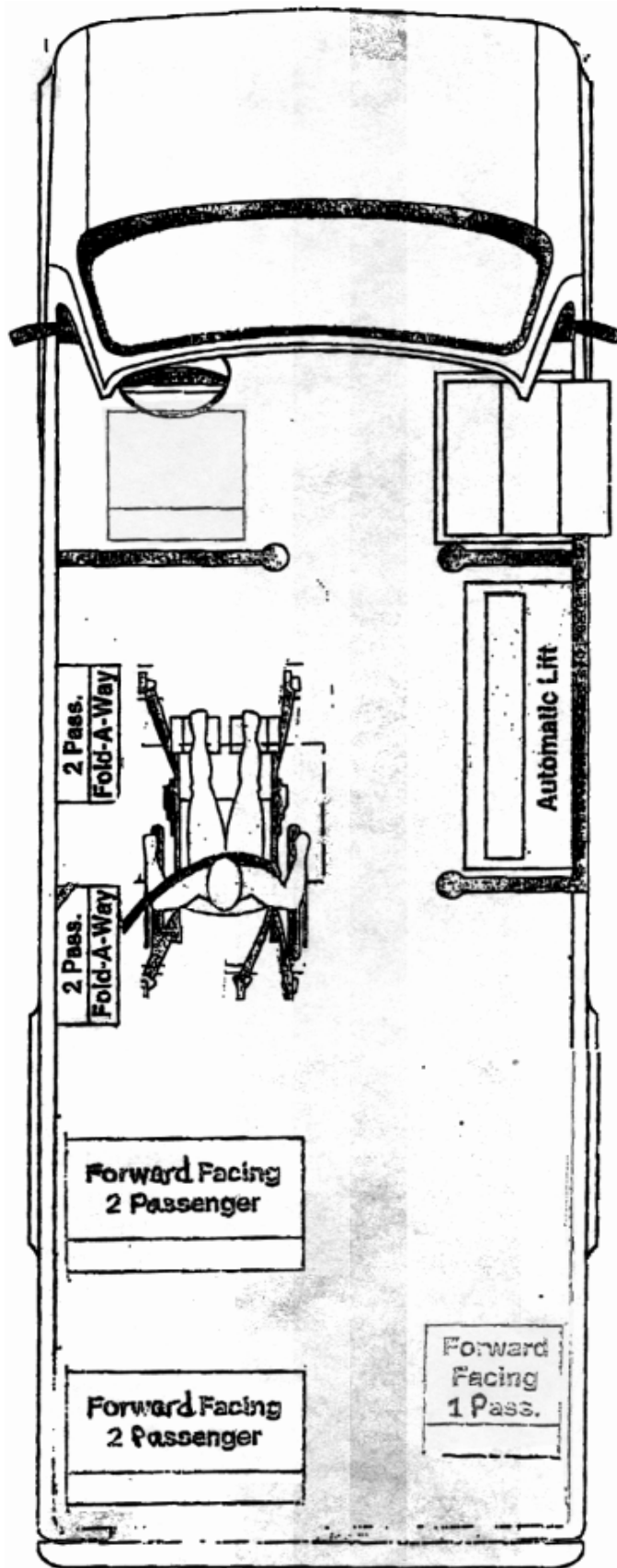
- Vertical padded stanchion poles and padded modesty panels are located behind entrance door, driver and rear of lift.
