In this session, PA State Trooper Glenn T. Bard, who specializes in investigating crimes of this nature against children, will discuss:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Who is most at risk to online predators, in terms of age, online characteristics and behavior, based on statistics offered by the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children. 2. Online victimization techniques and examine how predators befriend kids online and the six steps to luring, including the warning signs of offender manipulation and actual chat room sessions in which a 13-year old fictitious victim is approached by various potential predators. 3. How to protect students, offering general advice regarding safe Internet access and specific advice based on numerous prior cases. The GROW program, comprised of curriculum from the National Institute of School Leadership, is for principals and assistant principals with three or fewer years of experience. The SUPPORT program, addressing the Total Leaders Curriculum that has been adapted by the Pennsylvania Leadership Development Council, is for principals, superintendents, and human resource directors with three or more years of experience.
